Dear Sir / Madam:

We are pleased to inform you that we, on behalf of **Daejeon County, Korea Republic**, will host the 2014 Korea International Mathematics Competition (KIMC 2014) on 21-26 July 2014 in Daejeon County, Korea Republic.

The objectives of KIMC 2014 are as follows:

1. organize an international mathematics competition for key stage II (upper primary education) and key stage III (lower secondary education) students;
2. motivate teachers and students to improve the teaching and learning of mathematics with emphasis on developing the high-order thinking skills;
3. establish cooperation with networks for the improvement of mathematics at the international level;
4. provide students from participating countries with opportunities to exchange mathematics knowledge and practice and cultural experiences; and
5. upgrade mathematics curriculum in school to be at par with the international standards.

The competition is comprised of two divisions: Key Stage II & Key Stage III. We warmly invite you to nominate up to 4 teams for each division. A team consists of 1 team leader, 1 deputy leader and up to 4 student-contestants. Key Stage II students should not have enrolled in secondary schools or at any equivalent institutions, and should be born on or after 1 August 2000. Key stage III students should not have enrolled in upper secondary education or at any of its equivalent institutions, and should be born on or after 1 August 1997.

We will take charge of the cost of meals, accommodation and sightseeing of the teams during the period of the official KIMC activities (21-26 July 2014) at Daejeon County. Each team will be responsible for the travel expenses from its respective city or country to Daejeon County, Korea. Enclosed please find detailed information of the competition and the application form of the competition. One application form is only for one team, and all forms should be submitted to us via email on or before the deadline as indicated in the information brochure, and other requests should be directed to us via email as soon as possible.
