Dear Sir /Madam:

As Chairman of the Local Organizing Committee of China International Mathematics Competition (CIMC) 2015, I am pleased to cordially invite you to send teams representing your country for this year's IMC which will be held in Changchun City, Jilin Province, China on 27 July - 1 August 2015.

Changchun is the capital and largest city of Jilin Province located in the northeast of the People's Republic of China. Lying in the center of the Songliao Plain, Changchun which means "Long Spring" is known as China's automobile city for its key role in domestic automobile industry and for being a home to China's biggest producer FAW (First Automotive Works), manufacturing trucks and cars since 1956. It is famed for its beautiful Moon Lake National Forest Park and the stunning views of Changbai Mountain National Nature Reserve.

The organizer of this year's CIMC is the Attached Middle School to Jilin University offering a complete education from elementary to senior high school with philosophy based on the holistic students' development. Jilin University had successfully hosted the 2007 IMC, one important experience showing its ability to hold another similar activity this year.

Since mathematics knows no border, then we are inviting you to send two (2) teams to participate in the Key Stage II and another two (2) teams in the Key Stage III. Each team is composed of maximum 6 members, that is, 4 students, 1 team leader and 1 deputy team leader. The official period of the CIMC 2015 starts at 12:00 noon of 27th July and ends at 12:00noon of 1st August, 2015.

The organizer will take charge of all official expenses of the teams from each invited city or country including accommodations, meals, and sightseeing during the official period of the competition (27 July - 1 August 2015). The accompanying persons, observers and parents must pay US\$650.00 for the accommodation, meals, transportation, and sightseeing activity during the period covering the official dates of the competition.

Each participating team is responsible for the travelling expenses (including visa fees and other expenses for their entry to China) from their homeland to [Changchun Longjia International Airport](#).

We can't wait to look forward to your arrival and welcome you this summer in Changchun.
